The production started in the east area of Montalcino then expanded to other locations.

First the Cerretalto vineyard where in addition to a unique terroir inserted in a natural amphitheater on the Asso torrent, in the old vineyard there is also a Sangiovese different from the others,

with small and sparse bunches, from which a mass selection was obtained, subsequently used for our other vineyards, in particular the Tenuta Nuova.

The acquisition of the Cerretalto vineyard is followed by that of Le Cetine, Pietradonice and then Podernuovo. All this following exclusively the search for the best terrains and

exhibitions to produce unique and recognizable wines.

The first vintage produced by Brunello was 1978. Then follows Cerretalto 1981, Rosso di Montalcino 1982, Tenuta Nuova 1993, Pietradonice 2000, Ir-Rosso di Casanova di Neri 2006 and last IbBianco 2011. In our small but at the same time great story we have obtained in these years exceptional awards from most

important journals and opinion leaders of national and international specialized critics.

Currently the company covers an area of about 500 hectares of which 63 are vineyards, 20 are olive groves and the rest is arable land and woods.

The 63 hectares of vineyards are the heart of the company and their greatest wealth and extraordinary grapes come from them which are the secret of their wines. There is talk of 7 vineyards:

Fiesole, Poderuccio, Podernuovo, Le Cetine, Pietradonice, Cerretalto and Spereta, all in Montalcino and located in various locations in the area.

Their diversity of soil, exposure, microclimate and age of the vines represents the identity of these wines.

The wines produced are the consequence of how the Sangiovese in Montalcino gives unique and unrepeatable results, characterized by a unique quality resulting from the combination of a territory that has always been suited to viticulture and tireless work and infinite passion.

The grapes are the product of a mass selection of Sangiovese Grosso from the Cerretalto vineyard and a long process of reproduction and planting of the vineyards on the various sides that give different results but all attributable to Sangiovese and Casanova di Neri
