



The Villa Imperium winery was founded in 1920 in the Marche region, in San Savino di Ripatransone. Here the vineyards and water constantly draw their presence on the ancient skin of the fertile surrounding hills. A living monument to a man / nature harmony here achieved and perfected by need and intelligence. The same harmony that Giuseppe, grandson of the homonymous Cocci Grifoni founder of the company, and the winemaker, Primo Narcisi pursue in the creation of their wines. 40 hectares of land planted with vines of a total of 100, conducted with a biological system as a testament to the commitment to respecting the ecological balance and the passion for natural products.
