

From here begins the story of the Tenute Orestyadi, born in 2008 in the heart of the Valle del Belice, in Gibellina, Sicily, where Mediterranean scents and colors intertwine with myth and art. By transforming the arduous ascent into energy after a historically and economically complex moment, the 1968 earthquake, the whole has become a cultural and dialogue hub for the Mediterranean area.

The common thread of the reconstruction is the close relationship between agriculture and art, which becomes the company's identity. In 2018, thanks to the sharing of values and the same love for the territory, he began a collaboration with La Gelsomina, a reality on Etna.

A set of unique terroirs, characterized by different soils, specific microclimates and different altitudes to give origin to wines fruit of passion and dedication, as well as a deep knowledge of the Valley and its micro peculiarities: this is the strength of the vineyards cultivated the interior of the Valle del Belice.

Red, white and black earth meet, almost come close to touching each other, giving the right shade of color for each variety, painting unique landscapes and allowing those who dedicate themselves to the study of soils to find the most suitable lands for each cultivar.

Gibellina In a corner of Sicily where viticulture meets art until it merges with it, Gibellina, the Orestyadi estates were born in 2008. A journey through completely different terroirs, with rich and varied characteristics, which tell the sun and the gentle Sicilian breezes, with a common denominator: the ability to enhance the indigenous

varietals.

Mystical and fascinating place, Etna has always aroused amazement and interest, becoming a source of inspiration for artists, poets, writers, but also a place of religious worship, spanning the centuries and cultures.

Its soils, made up of stratifications of flows that have taken place over the centuries, allow heroic, complex but rich, highly distinctive agriculture. Here strongly identifying wines are born, expression of a unique and special territory.

Among the alleys of Presa, a small hamlet where the inhabitants leave the clothes of fellow citizens and become almost a tribe, La Gelsomina was born, a small jewel placed on the edge of the Santa Venera stream, where Piedimonte Etneo gives way to Mascali County.

On a lava and clay soil, walking day after day on the "gghiara", as the Etneans pronounce it, 15 hectares of vineyards, olive groves and orchards are cultivated, which take the form of a theater, as if to invite anyone who crosses the gate to enjoy the immense spectacle that is Nature, which is replicated and renewed daily
