



The "Cantine Angelinetta" winery, located in Domaso on Lake Como, was born in 2008 from the will of Emanuele Angelinetta and his wife Eleonora to transform what until then had been a family production inherited from the past into a small professional wine company.

In 2008 the turning point occurred: the meeting with Professor Leo Miglio (son of Professor Gianfranco Miglio, an illustrious political scientist and pioneer of Lariana professional enology) who for years had continued to develop the family tradition of making wine on the Lago di Como proposing and supporting the initiatives of valorisation of the vines-viniculture of our territory, including the recent qualification of IGT "Terre Lariane".

After this meeting, Professor Miglio decides to leave his vineyards in management where the autochthonous Verdesse grape stands out. The farm with the cellar and the sales area with tasting are located right inside the splendid villa of the professional, immersed in an incredibly suggestive panorama. The vineyards, located in Domaso, are clinging to the mountain on steep rocks and dry stone walls; conditions that require total manual processing. In addition to wine, the company has been producing (for over ten years) different varieties of honey: acacia, lime, millefiori, chestnut and honeydew.
